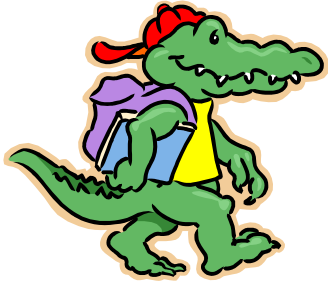

Five tales recounting the adventures of two best friends--Frog and Toad.
